 I should like to point out several things which do not
 appear to be clear judging from a preliminary study of
 the requests.

1. While many of the jobs involved are not Civil
 Service, they do require some special training as a pre-
 requisite.

2. All jobs require full-time service and permit no
 outside activity of a political nature or for pecuniary
 gain.

3. Finally, a good many of the positions being sought
 appear to be on the State level, which necessarily means
 that until a change can be made in the State or Regional
 Director, openings at a lower level will move very slowly.
